The 2019 Art LeTourneau Award for Collaboration and Creativity in Community Support

Community Mental Health for Central Michigan (CMHCM) is seeking nominations for the Art LeTourneau award. The award recognizes efforts to include all community members including individuals with developmental disabilities, mental illness, or substance use disorder, served by CMHCM, to live richer lives as included members of their community.



The award was created in 2001 to honor Arthur J. LeTourneau, of Midland, who died in 2002. He was the administrator of services for individuals with disabilities and acting director of Midland-Gladwin Community Mental Health Services. At work and on his own time, he helped individuals with disabilities and challenges to live richer lives in their communities. He was a pioneer in community-supported living and collaborated with community agencies to benefit many individuals.
