Below are situations and codes that are appropriate for CLS (H2015) staff to bill, if the <u>service/code</u> <u>has been prior authorized in the IPOS and medically necessary</u>. If you bill a service that is not medically necessary or prior authorized it could be denied. The IPOS should document the support the person requires during a medical appt. The CLS staff are required to be providing that support in the appt with the consumer and the medical provider to bill IND18. If you have any questions please reach out to the primary case holder.
