# INDIVIDUAL PLACEMENT & SUPPORT (IPS)/SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

Individual Placement & Support is designed for individuals with a mental illness when competitive employment has not occurred, been sustained, or has been intermittent.



## WHAT IS COMPETITVE EMPLOYMENT?

Competitive Employment: Work that is performed on either a full-time or part-time basis in which individuals are compensated for their work. The compensation paid must be at or above the set minimum wage, but not less that the wages paid to individuals who are not disabled and performing work that is the same or similar.

#### WHY IS IPS EFFECTIVE?

Who provides IPS Supported Employment? Employment Specialist work 1:1 with up to 20 people throughout the employment process.

This includes: Assessment of Job Skills/Experiences, Career Exploration, Resume Building and Applying, Interview Preparation, and Job Retention Services that help maintain a solid work experience.

"Working with the IPS program and finding a job has helped me stay focused, giving me a reason to thrive daily which has also helped my relationships."

Why IPS at CMH? Research has repeatedly demonstrated the effectiveness of Individual Placement & Support for those with a mental illness. Consumers, family members, businesses and mental health professionals have identified IPS as an important service as well as a vital part of a person's mental health treatment.



What is gained through competitive employment? Steady income, socialization within the local community, sense of purpose and self-worth, and skills to add to your career moving forward.

"When I first met with a consumer, he had stated that prior to engaging with IPS he had applied for positions and was not receiving any offers. We worked on appropriate communication skills and expectations when speaking and applying to potential employers. The feedback that was offered to him implemented new behaviors when applying for positions and now has successfully held a full-time position at a factory. This consumer is now eager to work toward a management position with the company."
