HOW TO GET STARTED

If you meet the qualifying health conditions and live in either Mecosta or Osceola county, REACH could be for you. The best thing to do to get more information is to call Community Mental Health for Central Michigan and ask about the REACH benefit. They can answer your questions about the program and how to best get the services it offers.
